



Instructions for poster presenters

1. Poster boards are **97 x 147 cm (width x height)**, so for posters in **portrait orientation**. Poster size should not exceed these dimensions. Please, use adequate letter type and size to ensure good readability. Well-designed figures, graphs and tables will generally increase the attractiveness of your poster.
2. Poster titles should be identical to the title of the corresponding abstract.
3. Poster boards in the poster area will be numbered by means of the abstract code (composed of one letter and two digits) appearing in the scheduling confirmation sent to you. You will also find your abstract code in the final program on the symposium website. We suggest you mention the abstract code on your poster for convenience of the poster viewers.
4. Posters should show the names and affiliations of all contributing authors.
5. The use of generic drug names is encouraged (trade marks may be added between brackets the first time a drug is mentioned). The identity of experimental agents should be disclosed by means of brief descriptions, structural formulas and/or full chemical names. Please be advised that ISDF2019 is attended by both prescribers and non-prescribers, so any form of promotion of prescription medicines is not allowed.
6. Any grants received in regard of the work described in the poster should be acknowledged.
7. Posters may be displayed throughout the duration of the symposium. Posters should be mounted on **Wednesday May 22 between 07.30 hrs and 08.30 hrs**.
8. Posters should be on display continuously from **Wednesday 08.30 hrs until Friday 18.00 hrs**.
9. There will be a scheduled poster discussion session during which you are asked to present your poster in approximately 3 minutes, with an additional 4 minutes available for Q&A. Poster presenters should be in the vicinity of their poster during the special poster viewing and discussion hours. Please see the final program for the exact time of your poster discussion session and the time reserved for poster viewing.
10. Posters should be ultimately removed on Friday, immediately after the last session. Posters that have not been taken away by **19:00 hrs** will be removed by the symposium organizers and will be destroyed.
11. Mounting materials will be made available by the local organizers. A poster area attendant will be available to provide instructions on the proper mounting of posters.
12. You are advised to bring hard copies of your poster as handouts.
13. The abstract's first and presenting author of a poster, scheduled for presentation at ISDF 2019, that without notice is not presented at the symposium, will be barred from having abstracts accepted for the next ISDF symposium.
